Understanding Formulaic Language: A Second Language---

The difficulty second language learners have in attaining nativelike formulaic idiomaticity and fluency raises issues of instruction (Meunier & Granger, 2008; Schmitt, 2004). Within the language learning and teaching literature, Nattinger and DeCarrico (1992) argue for the lexical phrase as the pedagogically applicable unit of prefabricated language.

Formulaic language is a linguistic term for verbal expressions that are fixed in form, often non-literal in meaning with attitudinal nuances, and closely related to communicative-pragmatic context.
