To harden modeling clay that's polymer-based, start by placing the clay on a ceramic baking dish. Then, bake the clay in the oven for 10-30 minutes at 215-300 degrees Fahrenheit, depending on what the packaging your clay came in says. When the clay is finished baking, immediately dunk it in a bath of ice water for 30 seconds so it stops baking.
